

Develop trilateral projects with French and African partners Fulbright Specialist - Special call for trilateral projects.

The Department of State (ECA) and the Franco-American Fulbright Commission are pleased to announce the establishment of a new program that aims to bring Fulbright Specialists to France and African countries. All African countries except for South Africa are eligible. This new Fulbright program explores the potential for developing trilateral cooperation between the US, France and African countries (except South Africa).

The objective is multifold:

Develop increased cooperation in eligible fields with Africa using both the U.S. and French networks in the continent Respond to an emerging demand in the U.S. for mobility in more than one country.

Facilitate the development of trilateral institutional linkages in order to facilitate the design of innovative study-research abroad opportunities for US, French and African students and scholars.

Develop capacities to host US students and scholars interested in Francophone destinations in both France and Africa.

FIELDS	Agriculture, American (U.S.) Studies, Anthropology, Archaeology, Biology Education, Business Administration, Chemistry Education, Communications and Journalism, Computer Science and Information Technology, Economics, Engineering Education, Education, Environmental Science, Law, Library Science, Math Education, Peace and Conflict Resolution Studies, Physics Educa- tion, Political Science, Public Administration; Public/Global Health, Social Work, Sociology, Urban Planning.

DURATION	6 weeks: 2 weeks in France + 3 weeks in one African country + 1 week in France
BENEFITS	Fulbright: international airfare & honorarium, Host institution : accommodation, access to university dining facilities, in-country travel expenses
DEADLINES	US applicants must register with the Fulbright Specialist Roster in advance. The host institution will apply directly on line, through the the World Learning platform by April 15, 2019: https://fulbrightspecialist.worldlearning.org/
SELECTION PROCESS	 The U.S. candidate's application is reviewed by World Learning and a peer review panel and approved by the J. William Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board. The approved candidate enters the Fulbright Specialist roster for 3 years. The trilateral project itself is submitted by the French host institution and reviewed by the Fulbright Commission in France. If approved, it is recommended for further review and approval by the.U.S. Department of State and the U.S. Embassy in the participating African country.
DATES OF STAY	Dates of proposed stay will be discussed between the hosts and the specialist.
